Savage Wilderness (SWS) has introduced additional measures to ensure the minimum risk to exposure the Covid-19 to our staff, clients and the general public within our camp, on adventure training and on any of our trips or expeditions.

All our staff have had an extensive briefing and training on the signs and symptoms of the Covid-19 using the MOH and WHO guide lines. If any of our employees or their family show signs and symptoms of the Covid-19 they are **NOT** to come to work and are to inform management by phone immediately. They are to then self-isolate along with those who might be exposed to the virus for 14 days minimum. If they require help they are to phone management and we will do what we can without exposing anyone to the virus. To maintain a working skeleton staff on the camp, all staff who can do their jobs from home have been sent home and are to work from home.

All of our activities and expeditions by their basic nature require social distancing, and are run in predominantly small groups. The activities take place in areas that the general population don't travel much beyond their home village. Please note the majority of the activities can take place on our camp with no need to leave the grounds. For the rafting you are on a boat in the middle of the river away from everyone. It is very unlikely that groups would come into contact with other people.

Prior to a groups arriving (given enough warning) we are asking all staff that will work with the group to live in the camp grounds and not leave for 7 days. We will take and record the temperature of the staff two times a day. They will also fill in a questionnaire designed to recognize the symptoms of the Covid-19 daily. We understand the importance that the staff need to work to earn their salary. They understand should they feel the symptoms of the coronavirus or have been exposed to someone who might of been expose or have the symptoms, they are to self-isolate and this will in no way compromises their salary or employment.

All communal areas (dining room, accommodation, washrooms, bar and reception) in camp are washed and disinfected 5 times a day. A detailed recorded cleaning schedule is in place.

We have implemented the following measures to meet GOK guidelines and ensure hygiene standards are met and that should there be any symptoms present that we are able to respond appropriately.

- **We have the green light (approval to operate) from the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of tourism & Wildlife**
- **We have the TRE (Tourism Regulation Authority) Covid-19 Compliance Certificate and Sticker**
- **All staff entering the camp have to wash their hands at the hand washing station at the gate and reception.**
- **All clients arriving at camp to be briefed by SWS staff member on additional Covid-19 measures in place.**
- **All client's personal details are recorded and stored (see our data protection procedure)**
- **All staff and clients to have their temperature taken when they enter the premises.**
- **All staff are to wear face masks (except on activities)**
- **All clients will be required to wear face masks when in public areas (except on activities.)**
- **All clients and instructors to carry face masks and to put them on if they have to interact with the public at any time**
- **Additional hand sanitizer to be carried by the instructor and given out when required.**
- **No handshaking, hugging, kissing as a greeting**
- **Additional hand washing stations are in place throughout the camp and are to be used regularly.**
- **Increased hygiene and cleaning has been made a priority within camp public areas. (all recorded)**
- **Information on Covid-19 are displayed around the camp on recognizing symptoms and what to do in the event of someone feeling those symptoms.**
- **All staff members are encouraged to follow the news and keep abreast of the situation and alert others where things are relevant.**
- **Reduced numbers of people in camp and reduced instructor client ratio. We will work 1:6 on activities and will operate at 50% our capacity. Therefore a maximum of 70 clients at one time.**
- **All items delivered to the camp will be cleaned and sanitized.**
- **Additional briefings on the Covid-19 for those arriving at camp explaining the additional measures in place.**

- Additional cleaning of all PPE equipment following manufacture guidelines.
- Accommodation and sleeping arrangements to be at a ration of less than 4 people per 10 meters squared (as per GOK guidelines) beds to be a minimum of 1.5m from each other.
- No buffet, meals to be self service.
